

Past Simple Tense

Definition: Past Simple Tense verbs are used for past actions that happened at a specific time, completed action, or past status. It can be given by a time phrase or understood from the context. Like for example: yesterday, last year, last summer and others.

Specific Past Action examples:

1. I **ate** lunch at noon today. (La oración está escrita de manera que demuestre que es más tarde de las 12 del mediodía.)
2. He **drove** to work yesterday. (*Yesterday* significa ayer; por lo tanto, el verbo *drive* se coloca en pasado, *drove*.)

Completed Action examples:

1. Jack finished his test on time.
2. She finally emailed the letter.

Past Status examples:

1. Juan was still single in 1995.
2. Felix was a movie star.
